"These awards showcase the global innovation that RegTech companies can provide to protect a broad range of organisations, and it's a real privilege to be named amongst them," adds Greaves. "RegTech is a critically important category for risk management, and Castlepoint was also awarded the 2022 Australian RegTech of the Year by the RegTech association.

"As seen in recent events, with regulated entities under increasing attacks from malicious actors in attempts to access data, when a breach occurs it's essential to quickly understand what the exposure was. Knowing and applying regulatory rules is one of the best ways to find all that risky data, track it, match it to the regulations and rules, and manage it compliantly, via AI."

Against this backdrop, and with rapidly growing data stores and regulatory obligations, organisations need a low-impact, high-coverage method to control data risk and value.

"We need to do what we can to reduce likelihood of a breach – but we can never completely prevent one. What we need to focus much more on is reducing the impact of a breach," continues Greaves.

"We must know our own data so we can focus our efforts on what has the most risk, which can include national security, sensitive personal information, and financial data. Then we must understand the risks specific to the organisation, whether that's IP, trade secrets, core business data, or regulated information – Castlepoint makes this possible."

Commenting on the chosen companies, RegTech Global said, "The RegTech100 recognises the next-generation of solution providers shaping the future of the financial services industry. These are the companies every financial institution needs to know about as they consider and develop their mission critical RegTech and digital transformation strategies and address the compliance challenges caused by remote working and the expanding use of digital channels.'
